Due to COVID-19 concerns, for your safety and the safety of our volunteers, we will provide *drive thru drop off/pickup service ONLY*.

## Stay in your car.

- 1. We will bring a tax preparation kit out to you. It details the information we will need from you to complete your tax return.
- 2. You can either take the kit home to fill out the forms or you can leave your tax information with us if you have everything with you.
- 3. We will make an appointment to conduct an interview with you via telephone or ZOOM videoconference.
- 4. We will prepare your tax return.
- 5. We will review the results with you by telephone or ZOOM.
- 6. You come back to our location the following Sunday to sign your return and get your copy to keep. Your documents will be returned to you.
- 7. We will e-file your return the same day that you sign it.

The IRS Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program offers *free* tax help to people who generally make less than \$57,000, persons with disabilities, and limited English speaking taxpayers who need help with preparing their tax returns. IRS-certified volunteers provide free basic income tax return preparation with electronic filing to individuals who qualify. *\*\*Please see a professional preparer for assistance with complicated returns.* 

### What You Need to Bring

- ◊ For married filing joint, both spouses must be present
- All Forms W-2 and 1099
- Information for other income
- ◊ Information for all deductions (including charitable contributions)/credits
- ◊ A copy of last year's tax return
- **6** For direct deposit of refund, proof of account and bank's routing number
- Social Security cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification documents for you, your spouse, and/or dependents
- **6** Government issued photo identification for you and your spouse (if married)
- **Oracle Series of Series and Series of Series and Serie**
- Birth dates for you, spouse and/or dependents
- ◊ Forms 1095-A, B or C (ACA Statements)
- Notice 1444, Economic Impact Payment 2020, if applicable

- ♦ Form 8814 (child taxed at parent's tax rate)
- Form SS-8 (determination of worker status for purposes of federal employment taxes and income tax withholding)
- Parts 4 & 5 of Form 8962 (Allocation of Policy Amounts, Alternative Calculation for Year of Marriage)
- Form W-7 (application for Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN))
